<p>2</p>	<p>New Blocks: Your Drill Kit will be delivered to your doorstep. Experienced Blocks: Your Refresh Kits will be delivered to your doorstep, to supplement your previous Drill Kits or Cache Duffles</p>	<p>Mid-September</p>
<p>3</p>	<p>Join the Drill Walk-Through via Zoom (neighbors welcome)</p>	<p>September 21, Wednesday 7-8 pm, via Zoom</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>Join the Communications Workshop via Zoom; invite your IC and Comms Lead</p>	<p>September 29, Thursday, 7-8 pm, via Zoom</p>
<p>5</p>	<p>Identify your Incident Commander (IC) and Comms Lead (you can ID other Lead roles beforehand, or wait for Drill morning)</p>	<p>October 1</p>
<p>6</p>	<p>Continue recruiting neighbors (minimum 8 needed). Look over Drill Kit, choose the scenarios you like.</p>	<p>First week of October</p>
<p>7</p>	<p>Send reminder email to your participants (sample on BNN website under Resources > Drill Lead Materials) Gather Drill Kit contents, or Cache duffle materials, any props.</p>	<p>A few days before</p>
	<p>Drill Day! 8am - Setup table/chair Command Post, plant scenarios on lawns 9am - Welcome neighbors, begin drill, enjoy!</p>	<p>Saturday morning October 8</p>
