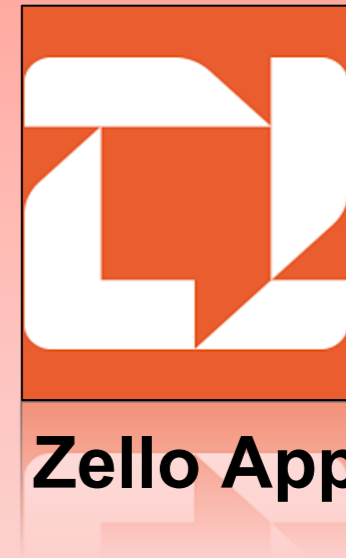
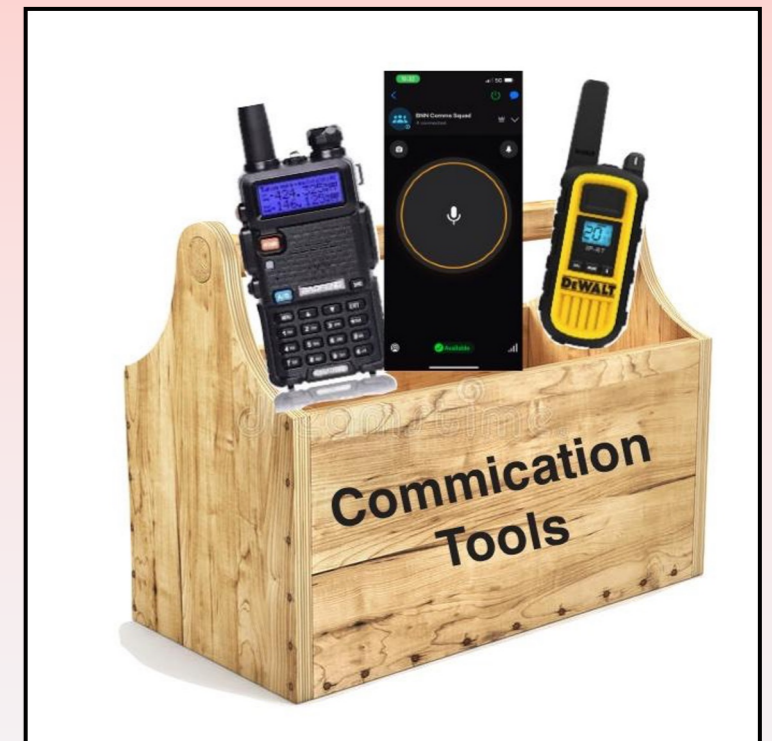


# Introduction to **Zello**

# What is the Zello App?

- The free App simulates traditional two-way radios with a walkie-talkie style of communication



- Works as long as you have a network cell data or a WiFi connection.
- Users can join channels and instantly send messages or photos.

# What is the Zello App?

- Unlike walkie talkies there is no specific distance the Zello app can broadcast. That's because users aren't actually broadcasting, they're adding their messages to a channel using data or wifi
- The app allows to talk one-on-one to a single person or in a channel with a group of people
